

# Purchasing Agreement

First and Foremost, we do not sell to Puppy Mills, Pet Stores, or Brokers!

**Pricing:** We do our very best to breed for quality, loving, sweet-tempered shih tzu puppies. Our prices are determined on quality, color and size of each individual puppy.

**Deposit:** A \$ 200.00 deposit is required once you have picked out your puppy. Please make sure that you are ready for the commitment of having a new puppy as your deposit is non-refundable. Deposits must be received within 5 business days, unless other arrangements have been made, or the puppy will no longer be on hold but will be placed back up for adoption. Deposits can be transferred to future litters if needed for up to one year.

**Balance:** The balance is due when puppy is 7 weeks old. Shipping costs and or mileage must be added into the balance and paid in full before the puppy will be released to go home. If balance is not received by the time the puppy is 8 weeks old, then the contract will be voided, the puppy will be placed back up for adoption, and the deposit is non-refundable unless other arrangements have been made prior to puppy turning 8 weeks old.

**Shipping:** Shipping is \$ 275.00 unless otherwise informed due to rising costs with the airlines. Shipping includes AKC/CKC Registration Papers, Veterinarian Exam & Health Certificate, Travel Crate, Airline Ticket, and Puppy Packet. We reserve the right to ship a puppy when we feel it is safe for the puppy to fly and the weather conditions are right. Our goal is to always send you a healthy, loving, sweet-tempered shih tzu puppy and we don't believe in compromising our goal. We want the very best for our puppies and our customers.

**Guarantee:** Please see our Contract and Health Guarantee Page. Our health guarantee is good for 1 year from the time you purchase your puppy. Please note that if at any time you are unable to care for your shih tzu, we will be more than happy to take the shih tzu back in and find a suitable home for it. We ask that you always give us this opportunity before ever placing the puppy in a shelter or a pound.
